IT'S POTENTIALLY A QUALIFIER!

We are in the process of getting a state proclamation so our event will be a qualifier (Jack Daniels draw, American Royal, etc.) if we have a minimum of 15 teams!

COOKING AMENITIES

Grease, ash, wastewater & garbage disposal and fresh water and limited electricity will be provided. All teams must have a 2A-40BC or 3A-40BC fire extinguisher onsite. No gas grills.

MEAT CATEGORIES

The meat categories will be Pork Butt, Chicken, Pork Ribs (spare or baby backs) and Brisket. **Painted Hills Natural Beef** is donating one whole brisket to each team.

SAMPLES & VENDING

Containers will be provided for teams who want to give free samples. There will be an opportunity to vend to the public on Saturday, July 5th from 5-7pm. The public will buy directly from each team and the teams can keep 100% of the money they take in. Teams can sell any menu items they choose but **NO BEVERAGES**. The Foundation will be selling water and pop. Teams who vend will need a temporary restaurant permit. However, there is no charge for the permit and we will take care of as much of the application logistics as possible. Be sure to check the box on the front of the form if you're interested in vending.

Complimentary breakfast will be provided on-site on Sunday morning from 6-8am.

CONDON'S FABULOUS 4TH OF JULY CELEBRATION

Condon is located 70 miles southeast of The Dalles, Oregon – about 2.5 hours from Portland and 2 hours from Pendleton. It is the county seat of Gilliam County and has around 750 residents.

Condon's signature event is its Fabulous Fourth of July. The celebration features a parade and soap box derby down Main Street and a community breakfast and dinner in the city park. For the athletically-minded, there is a tennis tournament, nine-hole golf tournament and fun run and walk. You're guaranteed a great view with no parking hassles to watch the fireworks.

The location is directly off Main Street right in the middle of all the activity. The downtown area is very pedestrian-friendly. Non-barbecuing family members will find plenty to do. There are great shops to browse and two places to buy espresso! The Liberty Playhouse Theatre features first-run movies and the Condon Swimming Pool is a great way to cool off. There is reliable cell service and wireless high-speed internet access available in the Hotel Condon lobby.
