## COOKING AMENITIES

Grease, ash, wastewater & garbage disposal and fresh water will be provided. **NO ELECTRICITY WILL BE AVAILABLE!** This is a change from previous years. Quiet generators are okay. All teams must have a 2A-40BC or 3A-40BC fire extinguisher onsite. No gas grills.

## MEAT CATEGORIES

The meat categories will be Pork Butt, Chicken, Pork Ribs and Brisket. **Painted Hills Natural Beef** is donating one whole brisket and **Two Boys Select Market** is donating two racks of baby back ribs to each team.

## VENDING ON JULY 4

There will be an opportunity to vend to the public on Saturday, July 4th from 5-7pm. Here are the details:

- The public will buy directly from each team and the teams can keep 100% of the money they take in.
- Teams can sell any menu items (except beverages) and pick their own prices.
- **PLEASE NO BEVERAGES!** The Foundation will be selling water and pop.
- Our vending event has been designated as *the* 4th of July community dinner in Condon so we expect to have 300-400 people attend.
- Bring plenty of extra change (\$1s and \$5s).

Teams who vend on Saturday night will need a temporary restaurant permit. Here's how to do that:

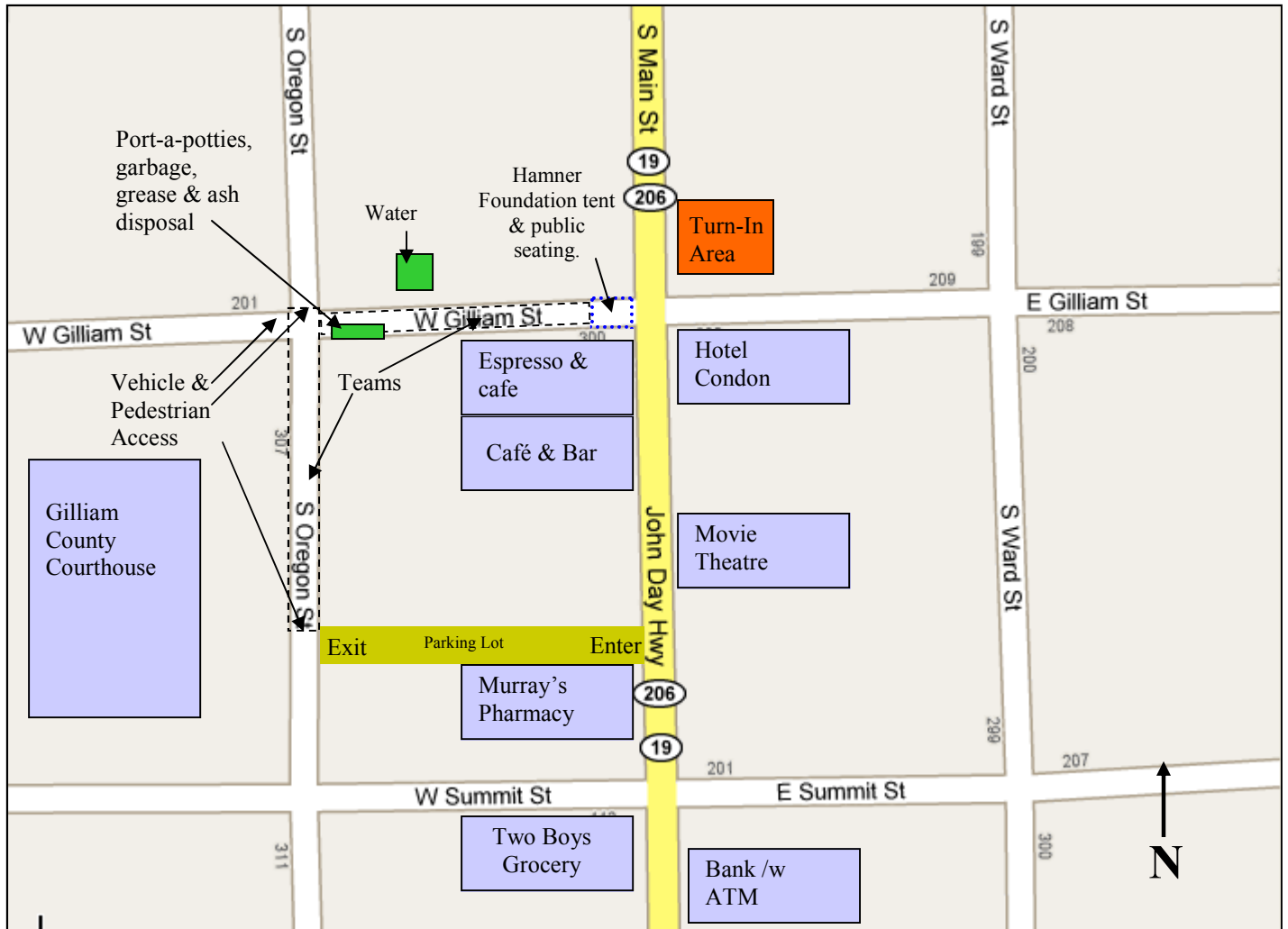

- Buildings are not to scale
- No vehicle access at the Gilliam and Main Street intersection after 9am on July 4. There will be limited access on Friday evening as we put up a large tent.
- Vehicle access is available from the south side of Oregon Street and at the Gilliam Street and Oregon Street intersection.
- Teams will be sited in the dashed areas. Teams arriving first will be sited on Gilliam Street closest to Main Street then south down Oregon Street.
- The Gilliam County Courthouse has new sidewalks running along Oregon Street. Those teams in front of the Courthouse are asked to keep their cookers on the pavement. No tents on the courthouse lawn as it has an automatic sprinkler system.
